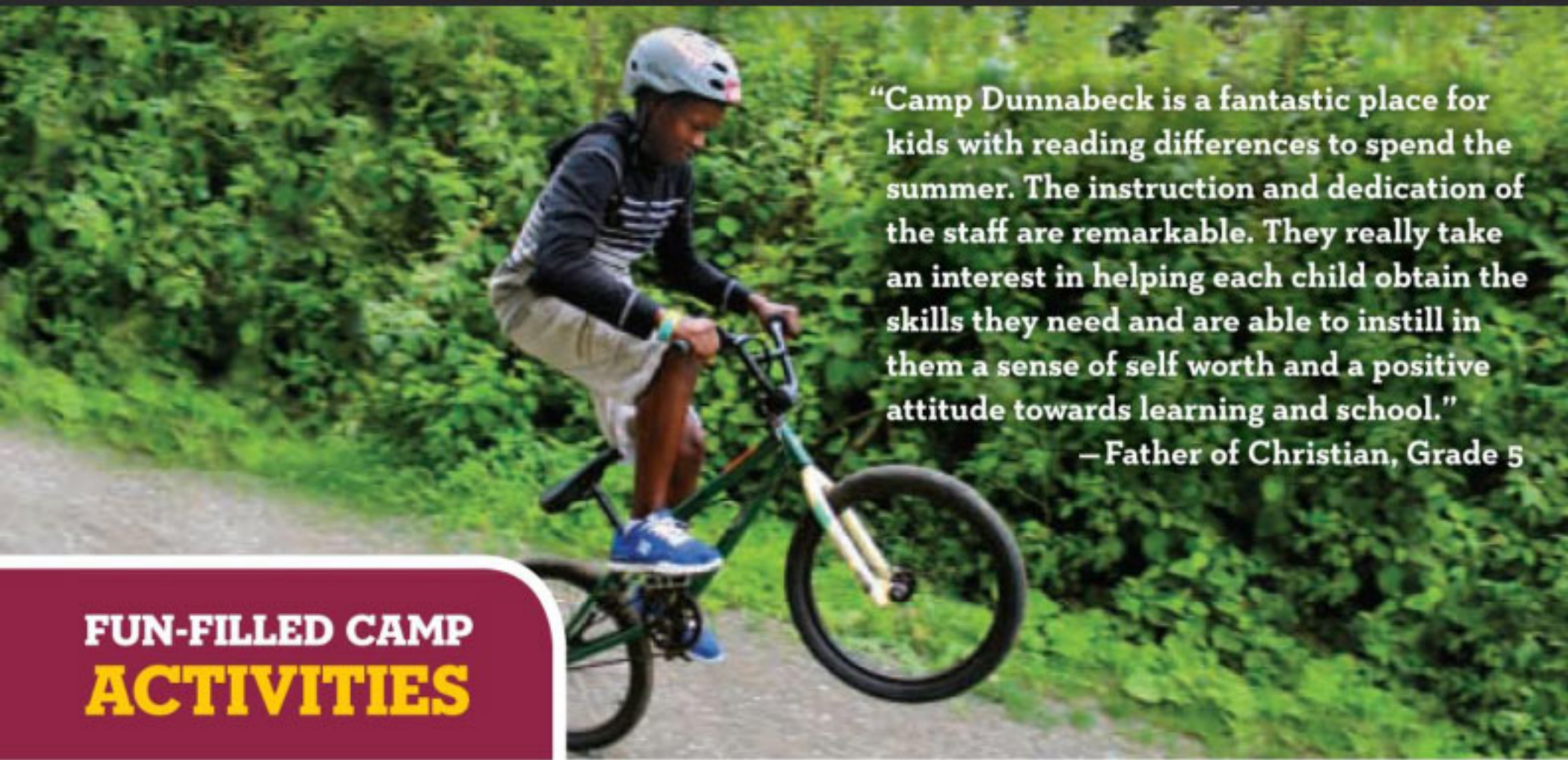

Camp Dunnabeck has helped thousands of young people with dyslexia achieve academic success. Campers meet with their Orton-Gillingham tutors for language training every day for a one hour, one-to-one, individualized session.
